

THE WELCOME WAGON RELOCATION PROGRAM


GJEP's Welcome Wagon program helps you establish strong connections and lasting roots in your new community.

This year-long program helps connect new residents with seasoned locals by providing free events that help you explore your new home and build a strong network.

AVAILABLE INCENTIVES



Mesa County & City of Grand Junction Personal Property Tax Rebate

A new or exisiting business that invests a minimum of \$1 million in new business facilities or equipment, and increases employment by 10% or one full-time employee, may receive a rebate for 100% of business personal property tax paid to Mesa County and the City of Grand Junction.

On-the-Job Training Program (OJT)

A limited-duration contract between an employer and the Mesa County Workforce Center that offsets wages while new employees are onboarding and training.

City of Grand Junction Sales & Use Tax on Manufacturing Consumables

Businesses have the opportunity to waive 100% of sales and use tax paid to the City of Grand Junction on manufacturing consumables used in its manufacturing process.

Expedited development review and fast-tracking of commercial project development reviews.

FEATURED STATE INCENTIVES*

Rural Jump Start (RJS) Program

New and expanding businesses may be eligible for a "tax holiday" and cash grants for up to eight years including up to \$20,000 as a newly established business and up to \$2,500 per new hire. GJEP has assisted 26 businesses with their acceptance into the program.

Job Growth Tax Incentive

This performance based program is for businesses pursuing job creation projects that would otherwise not occur in Colorado. Businesses creating at least 20 net new jobs within a credit period may be eligible for a state income tax credit equal to 50% of FICA paid.

Mesa County Enterprise Zone

Businesses can receive tax credits for specific (pre-certified) business operations, including hiring, providing health insurance, job training, obtaining a new business facility, and purchasing new equipment, if they locate or expand in a designated "enterprise zone."

Strategic Fund Incentive

Eligible businesses can receive cash incentives for the creation of net new full-time jobs in Colorado that are maintained for at least one year.



ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- · Be a market-ready for-profit business in a high-growth field
- Have all valid paperwork needed to conduct business in the United States
- Have the ability to pay a monthly rental fee for the intended term of the occupancy
- Have potential for a positive economic impact on the community through technology, product, or service deemed to have a high potential impact in the marketplace; and potential for the creation of new high-paying jobs
- Have a viable proof-of-concept, clear objectives, value proposition, and vision for growth
