State and Local Incentives

- New York State offers incentives to encourage business investment and economic development within the State. These incentives, which include tax credits, deductions, or abatements, can reduce a company's overall tax expenditures and support their success here in Oswego County. The State also has a 0% corporate tax rate for manufacturers.
- New York State's Regional Economic Development Council Consolidated Funding Application process awards more than \$750 million in state economic resources annually. These resources include capital, fully refundable grants and tax credits.
- Projects in Oswego County could be eligible to apply for local financing incentives, property tax abatement sales tax abatement and mortgage recording tax abatement programs through the Oswego County Industrial Development Agency. Additional programs could be available such as infrastructure grants through National Grid for sub-station development, electrical line extensions, transformers, gas lines, etc.



Workforce Ready Market

- Over 79,000 thousand advanced manufacturing jobs, 1,115 welders, 154,081 construction workers, 7,963 engineering degrees and 25,190 college graduates all within the Central New York region.
- Oswego County Workforce Development Board and Oswego County Workforce NY have several programs to help new employers identify and train new workers.
- Within the Central New York region, there are regionally 67 Manufacuring training programs with an annual enrollment of 1,195, 7 community colleges, 6 adult education providers and 8 high school technical programs.



Logistics, Natural Resources, Energy

- Oswego County offers convenient access to Interstates 81 and 90 which provide north/south and east/west movement through the state; The Port of Oswego is a deep-water port and the first port-of-call in the Great Lakes-St. Lawrence Seaway System; CSX rail service is available throughout the County, with direct access at the Port of Oswego and the industrial parks.; Oswego County also has a local general aviation airport and is within minutes of Syracuse's Hancock International Airport.
- Four industrial parks with hundreds of acres of shovel ready sites available through our site listings plus hundreds more available privately.
- Within Oswego County, over 5,500 megawatts of electricity are generated with extremely high reliability. National Grid serves 33 counties providing electric service to approximately 1.5 million customers and natural gas service to approximately 540,000 customers in upstate New York. Additionally, almost limitless water is available via Lake Ontario.
